Please feel free to make extra copies of the registration forms before filling out the form. Preregistration begins immediately. Please do not arrive at the camp prior to 3pm on June 17th. Children must not be left unattended at the camp before they are registered and no child will be registered on site before 3:00. We will have a snack shop that sells soft drinks, chips and candy (inexpensively), so make sure your camper brings snack money for the week.

Remember to mark your children's clothing with a permanent or laundry marker. Children will get extremely dirty during the week and especially after water activities, so they are encouraged to bring several changes of clothes. We strongly recommend you do not send new or nice clothes with your child. You will probably want to send an extra pair of shoes in case your child's shoes get wet.

Please remember to bring bedding (such as sheets, blanket and pillow or sleeping bag), towels, soap, toothbrush and paste, enough clothes, dirty clothes bag, and sporting equipment.

Please be aware that wearing <u>yoga or exercise pants is not permitted</u> or <u>shorts that are</u> <u>skin-tight</u>. Clothing should be worn loose enough to be modest, but not excessively loose. Also, <u>no offensive slogans or images</u> are allowed on the campers clothing.

All of the upper torso must be covered by the shirt, no tank tops, halter tops, strapless tops, muscle shirts are to be worn. Pants and modest shorts are the expected clothing for all times. The children will not be required to 'dress up' for services.

Please do not bring radios, CD/MP3 player, iPod/Tablet, TV, video games, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons or shaving cream.

Campers are allowed to bring cell phones to camp, but these are to be used only for emergencies. Counselors will take up cell phones that are being used at inappropriate times and they will be returned to the camper at the end of the week. If there are special circumstances requiring a camper to keep their phone with them at all times, please let us know at registration and arrangements can be made.

This is a church camp and curriculum is Bible-based. Your child will be taught Biblical Truths during class time and in chapel services. This is not a political camp but neither will we attempt to be 'political correct.'
